### A Message from our Principal

St. Eugene School is blessed to celebrate 55 years of Catholic education. This milestone allows us the opportunity to reminisce, celebrate our history, and look to the future with renewed hope and vision.

In preparing for our 55<sup>th</sup> celebration, I had the opportunity to uncover some fun facts about the early days of our school. We of course need to start with the fact that St.

Eugene Congregation celebrated its first parish Mass on July 14, 1957. Groundbreaking for the church and school took place on June 1, 1958. The school opened its doors in the fall of 1959.

The Sisters of Mercy were the founding sisters of our school. There were four sisters assigned to St. Eugene and they lived in what is now the library and computer lab. The Mercy sisters in the early years were partially cloistered and not allowed to leave the premises. They were separated from the lay faculty during the lunch hour by a sliding door.

The original wing of the school had eight classrooms. Students attended daily Mass. The well-known children's clothing designer, Florence Eiseman, designed the upper level girls' uniform. In the 1960s and 1970s, a full scale library opened, a gifted and talented program began, and a learning disabilities center was established. Enrollment peaked in 1975 with 446 students in grades 1-8. In the 1980s, increased resources and space were devoted to art and science departments, and a technology department began.

Now let's fast forward to St. Eugene School today. With the changing demographics we currently are a school with one class per grade, but we offer K3, K4, and K5 through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. We serve students from a wider geographic area and our make-up is 27% non-white. Our student body is 92% Catholic.

Students receive iPads starting in  $6^{th}$  grade. Technology is a tool infused throughout the curriculum and throughout the day. We are transforming the way we educate and are proud to have been awarded Exemplary Recognition by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee for our innovative 1:1 iPad program.

Our Catholic identity remains central to our school. Students attend weekly liturgies, pray daily, and religion class is taught by the classroom teachers and supported with visits from our priests. Our graduates go on to Catholic and public high schools, are on the honor rolls, and become valedictorians, salutatorians, and college scholarship recipients.

We are continuing the proud legacy that began 55 years ago and we are grateful to stand on the shoulders of all of our alumni. Looking to the future, St. Eugene School is committed to fulfilling its mission in order to provide many more years of educating young Catholic students. Thank you alumni for passing on to us what it means to be St. Eugene School!
